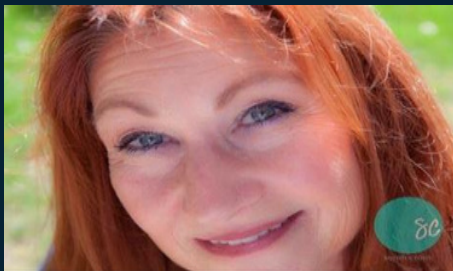

1. Define human trafficking as exploitation using the means of force fraud or coercion- unless the patient is a minor.
2. Define terms of trafficking, including labor, sex, commercial sex, forced criminality, familial trafficking.
3. Identify human trafficking as a wide spectrum of potential overlapping abuses, exploitation, violence, and trauma
4. Providers will understand the impact of exploitation and trauma and how this impacts youth requiring medical care.
5. Distinguish presence of red flags or indicators of trafficking during assessment.
6. Review assessment tools, RAFT, QYIT, and minors for sex trafficking.
7. Examine the 4 R's of Trauma Informed Care.
8. Consider the steps of a Trauma Informed Actions as an intake using Dr. Ravi handout.
